WHO IS IT FOR?

This course is a basic introduction for all levels of employees who do not have a managerial or supervisory responsibility and is suited to employees who work in all types of organisations.

AIM OF THE COURSE

To provide a grounding in the essentials of health and safety. Everyone must have an understanding of why they must work safely and this course introduces them to health and safety training that offers all the basics in a memorable and interactive format.

- Use appropriate workplace precautions for specific risks or seek advice on workplace precautions.
- Assist managers in preparing written risk assessments

- Carry out work activities without risk to themselves or others
- Report relevant accidents and incidents
- Monitor their own activities and assist managers in active monitoring
