Street furniture (lampposts, street signs, mobile phone masts, Wi-Fi transmitters, power cabinets, chamber covers etc.) has become a ubiquitous part of our urban landscape. Many businesses and organisations with high numbers of streetwork sites are looking for a practical way to ensure that each site complies with all relevant health, safety and environment legislation and does not put the public or employees at risk.



YOUR THREE POINT SOLUTION

Our team have an in-depth understanding of health and safety risks associated with the maintenance of streetwork sites and we have designed a comprehensive 3 point system that helps you to assess the status of each site, ensures that you comply with all relevant legislation, and recommends appropriate improvements where required. Together, these steps help you minimise your risks.

1) 'At Location' Audit

One of our team of trained and experienced assessors visits each streetwork site to conduct a comprehensive audit, covering health, safety, fire, environment, vandalism and structural issues. The audit includes a physical inspection of the site, generates site photographs and identifies any risks.



2) Online Audit Database

The audit findings are recorded in our secure online database, developed as a result of our extensive experience in the completion of streetwork audits.

The database records our assessor's responses to a comprehensive list of questions covering health, safety, fire, environment, vandalism and structural issues. Our assessor records any actions required to improve risks, provides a risk rating for each issue and uploads photographs of the site and of specific risks. The database generates an audit report (in pdf or Microsoft Word) and automatically e-mails the appropriate nominated representative with responsibility for closing each improvement action.

Customers have instant access to their audits via any internet link.

The database system also provides reminders for re-audits, helping you manage ongoing compliance.



3) Prioritised Improvement Programme

As part of the audit, our assessor identifies the risk level of each site. A prioritised improvement programme can be generated, with an individual risk ranking for each site, a detailed plan for improvement actions required, and a suggested timescale for completion.

Additional Services

If the audit raises issues that require more detailed investigation, we can offer support with follow-up activities.
